

*In the profile of Gary Grant, the narrator incorrectly substituted the word “counties” for “census block groups.” Here’s how the narration should have read (with corrected script shown in yellow):*

“Wing's findings are shown in this map of North Carolina. Shades of yellow indicate increasing percentages of people living below the federal poverty line. The darkest shade of yellow represents census block groups where more than 50 percent of residents are poor. In this next map, shades of red indicate increasing percentages of minority communities. The darkest shade of red represents census block groups where at least 90 percent of community residents are minorities. As you can see when the maps are overlaid, hog operations, shown as black dots, are more likely to locate in low-income and minority communities than elsewhere.”
